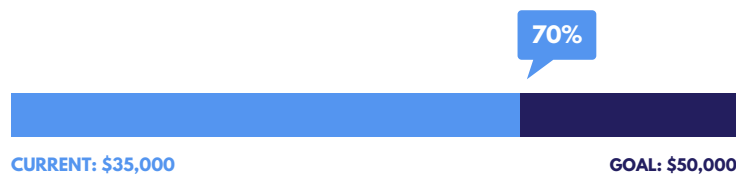
At the Center for Healthy Relationships, we believe God's design for marriage is worth fighting for. That's why we are launching a practical resource offering tools to strengthen relationships:
